

Introduction


TT 1000 granulate is an inorganic, flowable, and pourable microporous material with excellent thermal properties. It features very low thermal conductivity and maintains a very low density even after compaction. It is suitable for filling complex shapes or geometries with limited space structures and where shaped and rigid insulation cannot be applied.
